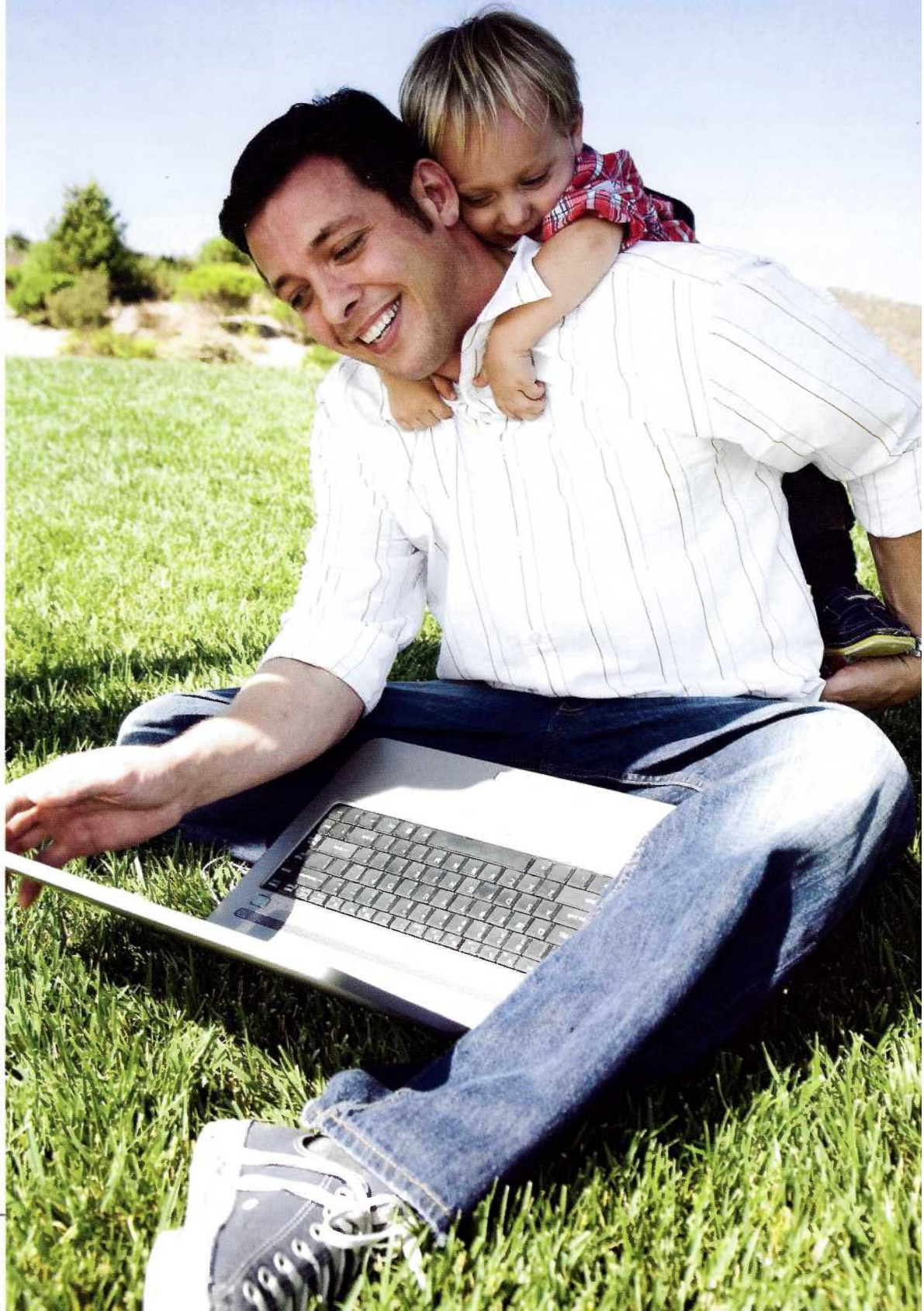

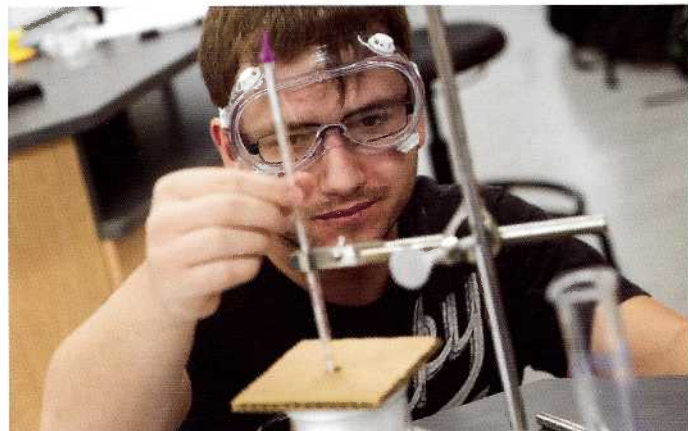
CLC offers the same general education courses you would take in the first two years at a university, but at a much lower cost.

CONVENIENT TRANSFER PROGRAMS

The University Center includes a wide variety of state universities and private colleges and universities that have strong academic reputations and provide personal attention to students. We offer "bachelor completion programs" (just the junior/senior coursework) so students can build on their CLC degrees or on coursework taken elsewhere.

Transfer agreements make clear how those credits will transfer, and some schools accept well beyond 60 hours of transfer credit.
