

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN HEALTH CARE MANAGEMENT



The Health Care Management (HCM) Bachelor of Science degree program with SIUC is designed to build upon the work experience and teach additional skills in the areas of management and supervision. This is a career-oriented degree program that meets the needs of and grants credit to individuals who have healthcare-related work experience and/or technical certification training from military schools, technical institutes or industry training programs. Many HCM graduates obtain supervisory and managerial positions in various health and medical facilities such as hospitals, nursing homes, public health departments, health care training institutions or HMOs.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum GPA 2.3/4.0 (2.25/4.0 and AAS in related field to apply for Capstone program)
- Background in health care
- Healthcare related goals
- Minimum 26 semester hours of previous college credit
- Must have English 101 with a minimum grade of "C" and prerequisites: med term, accounting, HCM 462 and microeconomics or macroeconomics.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

Summer, Fall and Spring semesters; each semester runs between 14 and 16 weeks

DELIVERY MODE:

The 48 semester hour HCM major is offered via weekend and online courses. Students may enter during any semester. Classroom courses meet every other weekend on Saturday & Sunday from 8 am to 4 pm for 4 weekend sessions.
