Trinity's Certificate in Christian Ministries equips students with skills to serve more effectively and faithfully in their churches and communities. Students study topics such as spiritual formation, evangelism, discipleship, and teaching the Bible.

TARGET AUDIENCE:

Those with a desire for church and community development throughout Lake County, IL and southern Wisconsin.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- 23 years of age (with some exceptions)
- Character recommendation from his or her pastor
- English proficiency
- Cumulative gpa of 2.0/4.0 scale for prior college work
- Transcripts from all colleges previously attended

COST:

Pricing for the Five Courses (including books)

- One-Time Payment = \$1,875 (if paid at the beginning of the certificate program)
- Monthly Payment Plan = \$2,000 (if paid in 20 monthly installments of \$100 each)
- For students who have already taken one or more of these courses, Trinity will adjust the total tuition accordingly.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

- The certificate program takes 20 months to complete, and students can begin at different times throughout the year.
- There are no course meetings in late November (during Thanksgiving), December, July, and August.
