## MASTER OF SCIENCE IN MECHANICAL ENGINEERING (MSME)

### TARGET AUDIENCE:

Individuals interested in completing an MS degree in mechanical engineering or taking courses for professional development. Individuals must have a BS degree in mechanical engineering from an ABET accredited institution. Both thesis and non-thesis options are available.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum GPA – 3.25/4.0 scale.
- TOEFL scores for international applicants.
- Complete Graduate College application with \$70 fee for domestic applicants and \$90 for international applicants.

### DELIVERY MODE:

Courses offered online.

### REQUIRED COURSES:

*Thesis Option* – 32 hours of credit required, including ME599 - Thesis. 16 hours must be at the 500-level with two of the three courses taken in mechanical engineering.

*Non-Thesis Option* – 36 hours of credit required, including ME 597 - Independent Study (non-thesis project). 12 hours of 500-level courses, two of which must be in mechanical engineering.
