DELIVERY MODE:

Hybrid Cohort: Hybrid cohort programs are offered one night a week with a start-to-finish calendar on-site at UC. Classes are held in the evening and online via Desire2Learn (D2L). Some courses are face to face only and some are only online. Students attend classes full time and complete the program in two years or less.
