This array of online graduate certificates is designed to provide managers and leaders with a pragmatic education that addresses the special concerns and problems of managing in a rapidly changing world. All coursework may be applied to any of North Park's five graduate management degrees, including the MBA which is offered in Lake County.

## TARGET AUDIENCE:

Professionals who seek to expand their career options and scope of responsibility through focused management education.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- A baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution
  - Completed application, essay and current resume
  - Official transcripts from all previous schools attended
- Students may begin courses in August, January, and May.

## COST:

2017/18 – \$2300 per course  
(2 Semester Hours)  
2018/2019 – \$2340 per course  
(2 Semester Hours)

## ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

Six 7-week quads per year, starting in August, October, January, March, May and July.

## DELIVERY MODE:

Online only.

## TEXTBOOK PURCHASE:

Online from North Park's Bookstore, or from another online provider.

## TRANSFER HOURS POLICY:

Graduate transfer credit may be used to obtain certificates.

## TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:

10 semester hours are required to earn each certificate.

## FINANCIAL AID INFO:

North Park offers one of the most comprehensive scholarship programs for part-time graduate students in the U.S. Eligibility for scholarships does not require a separate application and you will automatically receive the highest scholarship for which you qualify. Scholarships for high GMAT/GRE scores and/or high cumulative GPAs range from 10-30% of the cost per course, depending on score or GPA. An Axelson Scholarship reduces tuition by 35% for full-time employees of nonprofit organizations, local, state, or federal government, or those who have completed a successful tour of service with the Peace Corps, AmeriCorps or Teach for America. Federal Stafford Loans and convenient payment plans are also available.
