

# BACHELOR OF SCIENCE WITH A MAJOR IN NURSING FOR RNS



Designed for registered nurses who want a bachelor's degree. Students study the health continuum across the life span of clients, develop individual and team skills, and learn to apply knowledge in the practice setting.

## TARGET AUDIENCE:

Licensed RNs

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Submit a completed Olivet Nazarene University application form.
2. Application fee waived for UCLC.
3. An associate degree in nursing from a regionally accredited institution or a diploma from a school for registered nurse education.

4. Official transcripts\* from all previously attended institutions.

\*Official Transcript: A transcript with the registrar's seal from the institution granting credit sent directly to the Olivet Nazarene University, School of Graduate and Continuing Studies, One University Avenue, Bourbonnais, IL 60914-2345.

5. Submit a copy of a current R.N. license.
6. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or better (4.0 scale) from all credits transferred from institutions previously attended.

## COST:

University Center students receive an automatic tuition discount of 20%, making the cost for the 30 hours of core nursing credit \$364/hour or \$10,920, plus the \$100 graduation fee. Olivet requires all undergraduate students to take two upper level Bible courses in addition to any general education and/or elective courses needed to reach the required 128 credit hours for graduation. The Bible courses, gen ed, and elective courses outside of Nursing Core track will be charged at a rate of \$220 per credit hour for 100-200 level courses and \$340 per credit hour for 300-400 level courses.\*

## REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Once students have been accepted into the program, they are automatically registered for the next course in the program.

## ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

Our program is not bound by the semester system and begin year round as needed.

## DELIVERY MODE:

A hybrid program with half of the classes online and half in a traditional classroom setting. Classes meet one night per week or via online study. Fast track and a fully online option are also available. Program can be completed in 15 months using the cohort system.

## LOCATION(S) OF COURSES:

Classroom classes are held at the University Center of Lake County, Grayslake campus.

## TEXTBOOK PURCHASE:

A list of textbooks will be provided, and students can purchase books from the vendor of their choice.

## TRANSFER HOURS POLICY:

Students who enter with an A.A. or A.S. degree from a regionally accredited institution will have met all general education requirements. However, students may be required to complete additional elective courses beyond the required core to satisfy the 128 hour graduation requirement. Transcripts of students without A.A. or A.S. degree will be evaluated on a course by course basis to determine transferrable credits. A maximum of 82 hours will be transferred from a community college.
