TARGET AUDIENCE:

RNs (or soon to be RNs) looking to earn a rigorous, recognized nursing degree from a nationally ranked program, and needing the flexibility of an online program.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Transferable Cumulative GPA of 2.75
- Transferable Science GPA of 2.5
- 57 transferable credits that meet both the Core and General Education Pre-requisite Requirements: <https://bsn.ec.uic.edu/admission-requirements/>

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Once a student is accepted, an advisor is assigned to help guide the student through the registration process. There are also online orientations that take place prior to the start of term.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

We are on the semester system. The 16 week semesters are split into two 8-week sessions. (Summer semester runs 12 weeks, split into a 4-week and 8-week session)

The start terms are traditional: Fall (End of August), Spring (Beginning of January), and Summer (Mid-June).

TRANSFER HOURS POLICY:

A student needs 57 transferable credit hours to start the program. Once accepted, the student completes 30 credit hours through UIC and is awarded 33 proficiency credit hours for having RN licensure, for a total of 120 credit hours.

TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:

30 credit hours (8 courses) in residence; 120 hours for the degree.

The program also requires a 3 credit hour upper-division liberal arts course. This course must transfer to UIC as a 200-level course or above and is typically satisfied by either the Microbiology or Life Span Human Growth and Development course.

SPECIAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Courses are completed one class at time, in an 8-week format. This allows students who have just completed their ADN to begin working, allowing them to gain experience in the field while completing their BSN. The 30 credit program has no "hidden" courses. We offer upfront, pre-application advising for pre-requisite requirements, so a student is able to see, transparently, what is needed to complete the degree.
