NEXT "UNIVERSITY CENTER NIGHT" TO BE JULY 15

The University Center of Lake County will host an Education Fair at the Grayslake facility to highlight the more than 80 programs available. "University Center Night" will occur on July 15 from 6 to 8 pm and will enable prospective students to learn about the bachelor's completion, graduate degree and professional development programs offered through the Center. Representatives from the University Center's eighteen member institutions will be available to answer questions and provide further information about the programs offered. This will include



representatives from the Center's newest programs: a bachelor of science in Health Care Leadership and a master of Health Services Administration, both from National-Louis University and both to be offered in Waukegan; and a bachelor of general studies and bachelor of arts in Criminal Justice, to be offered in both Grayslake and Waukegan by North Park University. The National-Louis programs will begin in Fall 2008 and the North Park program will begin in Fall 2009.
