Grayslake, IL (June 15, 2018) The University Center of Lake County has added almost a dozen new degree and certificate programs for the 2018-19 academic year. All of these programs and more will be showcased at the University Center Open House on Wednesday, June 27 from 6 - 8 pm at the University Center's Grayslake facility (1200 University Center Drive). In one visit, attendees can pick up a newly-printed *Program Guide* describing more than 130 academic options available in Lake County from multiple institutions plus meet with program representatives to ask questions about curriculum and admission.

All University Center programs are offered via evening or weekend or online study so that working adults can complete degrees without relocating to distant campuses or adding lengthy commutes.
